Dear Parent/Carers

There has been an increase in the number of positive COVID-19 cases at Lea Manor High School.

We can confirm that all those young people who have either tested positive for COVID-19 or have been identified as a close contact, are now self-isolating for 10 days.

Please help us to keep the school open and running smoothly, by ensuring your child does not attend school if they or anyone in their household has symptoms of COVID-19. Instead, follow the [guidance on self-isolation](#) and book a free test, either [online](#) or by calling 119. If they do not fall into this category, they should attend school as normal.

We have plenty of Lateral Flow Test kits available here in school, please contact our dedicated email address to order further supplies. Should your child test positive from a Lateral Flow test, a PCR test must be obtained within 2 days and the results shared with school. The email address is as follows:

Please continue to test your household twice a week, this should ideally be carried out on a Sunday and Wednesday.

If your home rapid test is positive you should:

- either call 119 or book a regular PCR test online
- self-isolate and only go out to have the PCR test
- self-isolate until the results are received from the PCR test

If that test is positive then you need to complete the 10 days isolation period. If it comes back negative then you can stop self-isolating. Please always advise school of any result by emailing the above email address.

If you are testing at home you will need to [register your results online](#) or by calling 119.
